SRM Name: Slurried Spinach

Description: This SRM is intended primarily for use in validating methods for determining proximates, calories, carotenoids, vitamins, and elements in spinach and similar matrices. This SRM can also be used for quality assurance when assigning values to in-house control materials. A unit of SRM 2385 consists of four jars of slurried spinach containing approximately 70 g each. This SRM should be stored at 4 °C until required for use. For storage and use instructions, see the Certificate of Analysis.

Additional Notes: For laboratory use only. It is NOT for human consumption.

Disposal: SRM 2385 should be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
